




Reducing Orthopedic Surgery Patient Harm Events

In an analysis of our medical professional liability (MPL) claims*, surgical allegations are #1 in occurrence and #2 in cost. **Orthopedics is the most frequently cited specialty team** responsible for care at the time of the alleged patient injury with **28% of claims and 20% of costs**.






Orthopedic surgical performance allegations
